1. Fundraiser total sales were \$24,542.00; costs were \$9,662 (prize money pay out, LaVera, purchased auction items, printing invitations). Net: \$14,882.00
2. W-E SOI Bank Acct. balance: \$31,753.00 (Treasurer's Report)
3. Request for 8th grade class trip to Cedar Point. Total cost is estimated at \$3,500.00. a request was made for the PTO to fund 1/2 the cost of the ticket. With group purchase, 9 additional free tickets are included for a total of 84. Future 8th grade classes will be aware of the Cedar Point trip and be responsible for fundraising throughout the year to pay their own way without compensation from PTO.

A motion was made for PTO to pay 1/2 cost of tickets for 8th Grade Cedar Point Class trip. Motion passed.
